RE: Students' Union Superannuation Scheme "SUSS"- Member Nominated Trustee Election Result

Following the recent Member Nominated Trustee Election I am pleased to announce that Jamie Agombar has been elected as a Member Nominated Trustee.

Jamie has worked in the students' union movement for the last 22 years, having first joined NUS in 2003 as ethical supply chain coordinator. Working with officers and staff, in 2005 Jamie developed Green Impact, NUS's first proactive sustainability programme which, along with other programmes, helped position the movement as a sustainability leader. Since 2019, Jamie has been the Executive Director of SOS-UK, an independent environmental charity which he led in setting up in response to the youth climate strikes.

Jamie is also an experienced non-executive director, having been on the board of the Aldersgate Group, the UK's business lobby on environment, for the last seven years. Additionally, Jamie is Chair of Harmony, a small educational charity that delivers the King's harmony philosophy into education. Jamie also sits on University of Bath Court, the British Academy's Public Policy Committee and the Department for Education's Sustainability User Group, and has recently started supporting NUS Charity with its ethical supply chain work once again.

Jamie is aware that pensions and investments have a huge environmental impact and make up a large part of our carbon footprint. As a SUSS pension holder, and being a keen environmentalist, Jamie is eager to work alongside the SUSS Trustees to ensure the Scheme delivers both a good financial return and helps to make the world a better place.
